Show Day Etiquette

As a friendly reminder it would be much appreciated if all competitors could keep the following points in mind to ensure our shows run well and without incident:

- NO ponying of horses in the loping area (NCHA rule)
- NO training of horses after the bell has sounded at the completion of your run.
- Adhere to dress codes at all times whilst in the arena and loping area (collared long sleeved shirt and hat)
- NO drinking of alcohol within the arena or loping pen.
- All entries are to be paid up with the Secretary by Saturday finish.
